vineyard: I Selvatici, {the wild ones} West Addison, (Champlain Valley, Vermont) soil: clay and calcareous, lacustrine sediment (historically this land used to be sea and lakebed)

elevation: 84 ft. Valley floor. Lake coast. varietal: La Crescent. Varietal cross. Vinifera parentage tracing to Moscato d'Amburgo.

alc. %: 12.5

notes: The La Crescent was handpicked from our West Addison vineyard at the end of September, after a near perfect growing season with plenty of sunshine. The fruit was hand-destemmed and sorted then foot~crushed. Fermentation on skins took place in open vats for 4 weeks with native yeast. Elévage was partially in anfora made in Montreal with local Champlain Sea clay and demijohns, and over a one year. One year in bottle. No sulfur or other additions.
