

## Weingut Tscherne 18 Sauvignon Blanc Classic



**Vinification & Yield**: Grapes are sourced from multiple vineyards. Hand-harvest mid-September. Fermentation in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks. Pre-fermentation: 24 hours cold maceration, which slows down the activity of the yeast to produce amazing flavors.

**Tasting Note:** A wonderful fruity, fresh nose, full of flavor, aromas of spicy apples, quince and citrus

fruits, convincing finale with lively character and spicy aromas.

## **Producer Information**

The winery Tscherne - Strauss is over 200 years old, Karl Strauss bought it in 2006. Our winery is called Strauss vulgo Schopper, and Mr. Schopper was an architect and builder who sketched and built the house at the winery as well as the Tscherne house. Therefore, it was a must for us to purchase it. We have revitalized this house and rebuilt the barn building. To preserve the history of the property, we carefully restored and rebuilt the original attic of the barn building and left everything as it was. We created 5 double rooms with a large terrace and a small but fine wellness area with a wine barrel sauna. The wines that we produce and serve reflect the history of this house. We continue the tradition of producing our wines in 300lt, 600lt and 1200lt - (half, statin and Doppelstatin - that's the barrel sizes). Just like in the old days. We are currently building a little "Buschenschank" or Heuriger - a small tavern with delicacies from our region. Run by Gustav & Bettina Strauss. The Tscherne Strauss wine estate is located in Steinbach, near Gamlitz. The enormous Gamlitzberg is the largest single wine-growing area in Southern Styria. Vineyard size 20 acres. Total annual production: 60,000 bottles.
